▶ PLACEMENTS AVAILABLE

Two to three year 2 or 3 placements per year. Placements are usually taken up at the beginning of Semester One and may be for a period of one to two years.

▶ DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

Generally placements are finalised between October and December of the year prior to placement, however Care NZ welcomes enquiries from students and/or placement coordinators throughout the year.

▶ WHAT MIGHT I EXPECT TO LEARN?

Students on placement at Care NZ become part of the life of the agency and will be provided with formal induction and training to ensure they understand and are able to comply with CareNZ's policy and procedures.

When ready, students with informed consent and regular management supervision are able to case manage a small caseload of clients for individual counselling (to achieve placement hours) and may also take part in group programmes where applicable.
